Cece Hughes portrayed the Blessed Virgin; Bruce Kerber, Joseph; and Gary Butler, the innkeeper. They all sang together. Debbie Duepner, Shirley Hunz and Sue Meehan sang a short trio part. Alicia Hughes and Jenny Stein played the parts of two little girls.

On the day of the performance, about 12 boys and girls were sick with

the flu, but we still did an exceptionally good job.
